

Accessibility Statement

Introduction

We aim to provide an accessible site to all our guests.

Arrival and Car Parking facilities

We operate a contactless checkin procedure and all our guests are provided with a code for entry through the secure gates to the site and codes for the key safe to obtain keys if they are staying in one of our glamping units.

There is a grass car parking area for the camping pitches, guests are welcome to drop their belongings off via their car then park up in the grass parking area. Pitches 1 and 7 are nearest to the parking area so are the most suitable pitches for guests with mobility problems.

The glamping units are not accessible by car. Car parking is provided near the toilet and shower block in a level concrete car park. Wheel barrows are provided for guests to take their belongings to their glamping unit.

Public Areas

The site is made up of different surfaces.

Campsite

The campsite has a grass surface and is quite level and solid. Roads are concrete and level. Paths down to the glamping units do have some inclines, hawthorn pod being the furthest away from the car park and facilities.

Facilities

The shower and toilet block is in a hand built shepherds hut which has 3 steps up on entry.

The bell tents have a slight lip in the fabric around the doorway and plenty of room to move around inside. The floors have large mats with no trip hazards.

The camping pods have one step up onto the decking out the front and are level inside with solid wood floors. Rosie's pod has its own private toilet in a shed to the rear which has a slight lip on entry then level wooden floor inside with plenty of space.

Poppy's hut has 3 steps up onto the decking outside with a handrail. It has a level entrance from the decking into the hut and a solid wood floor throughout it is en-suite with a toilet and shower. The shower tray has a slight lip to the front. The bed is raised quite high of the ground and folds down into position.

The lodges have two steps up to the entrance and are level throughout with laminate floors. They are ensuite with toilet and shower, the shower tray has a slight lip to the front. There are two bedrooms with divan beds, one double and one twin.

Ireby house is fully wheelchair accessible it has a paved area by the car park to unload onto and a level path with slight incline to a set of bifold doors at the rear entrance which is fully level with no lips. The floors inside are solid wood throughout the main living areas with non slip flooring in the bathroom and purpose built wet room with walk in shower. Grab rails are installed in the wet room shower area and to the toilet. The wet room also has a built in shower seat. There is one double bedroom and one twin with divan beds. The bedrooms are carpeted. The kitchen is galley style and has lots of room for moving around, the microwave and oven are fitted at eye level for ease of use. The large garden is part paved and part lawn both are flat and accessible for wheelchair users.

Grounds

The roads and paths on the site are wheel chair friendly. The nature trail and footpaths around the farm however are not really wheel chair friendly.
